

NUR-113 Family Health Concepts

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Prerequisites: NUR 112, NUR 114, BIO 168, BIO 169, BIO 271, PSY 150, PSY 241, ENG 111, Must be enrolled in Associate Degree Nursing Program

Co-requisites: NUR 211, ENG 112

This course introduces the concepts within the three domains of the individual, healthcare, and nursing. Emphasis is placed on the concepts within each domain including medication administration, assessment, nutrition, ethics, interdisciplinary teams, informatics, evidence-based practice, individual-centered care, and quality improvement. *Upon completion, students should be able to provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified in this course.*
