EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

Durham Tech will notify students and employees through text, email, and push notifications. For questions on how to receive emergency notifications, call the ITS Help Desk at 919-536-7261 or email helpdesk@durhamtech.edu.

FIRE

- Activate alarm for smoke or fire.
- Evacuate immediately, close doors behind you, and DO NOT use elevators.
- Call 9-1-1 after evacuating.
- Move quickly to designated assembly area or safe distance from building and emergency vehicle access areas.

BOMB THREATS

- Stay in place until Campus Police clear an exit route.
- When clear, **evacuate** and close doors behind you.
- Note the exact location of suspicious objects, but do not touch them.
- Move quickly to designated assembly area or safe distance away from the building.



- DO NOT use cell phones.
- DO NOT touch or move suspicious objects.
- DO NOT activate fire alarm.

EARTHQUAKE

- Evacuate building if time permits.
- Otherwise, take cover under a desk, table, or door frame or sit on the floor against an interior wall.
- Cover your head and eyes with your arms.
- If outside, move to an open space away from buildings and utility poles. Avoid downed power lines.
- Be prepared for aftershocks.

ACTIVE SHOOTER

- **GET OUT** If there is a safe escape route, run to it without running in a straight line.
- CALL 9-1-1 Once in a safe place, call 9-1-1 and report the following:
 - Your exact location on campus.
 - Number of intruders and direction of travel.
 - Complete physical description.
 - Types and numbers of weapons.
 - Identity of suspects (if known).
 - Victims, descriptions and locations.
- **HIDE OUT** Get to an area where you are well-hidden and well-protected if you can't get out of the building safely.
- **KEEP OUT** Lock yourself in a room, turn off all lights, barricade the door with heavy furniture, and silence all noise-producing objects (e.g., cell phones, computers).
- SPREAD OUT Do not huddle in groups. Have a plan of attack in the event the intruder comes into your area.
- TAKE OUT Be prepared to do whatever it takes to neutralize the threat. Throw things. Yell. Use improvised weapons. If there are two or more of you, make a plan to overcome the intruder. Do the best that you can. Choose to survive!

TORNADO



- Move to Weather Shelter Area as shown on the Evacuation Plan map when a tornado warning is issued.
- Evacuate and close doors behind you.
- **Stay away** from windows, glass doors and rooms with large roof spans.
- Get low and protect your head with your arms.
